Relative Risk Profile



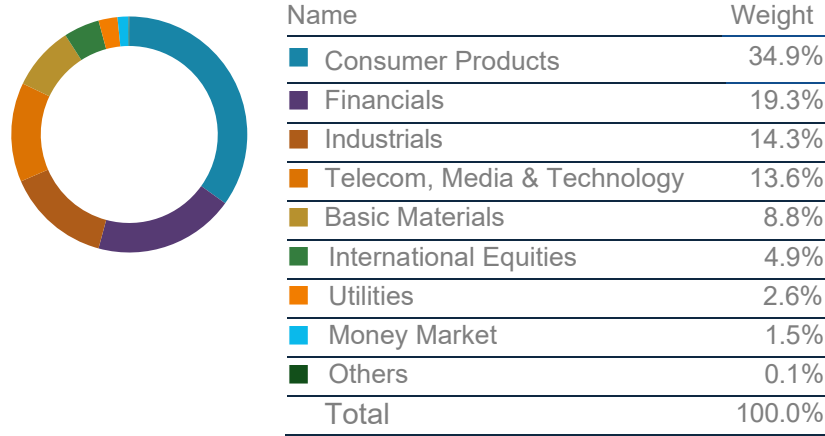
